# **Update on Transitional Ministry**

**The Transitional Ministry Study Group**, composed of Herb Hethcote, Jeff Philip, Patricia Erdmann, Liz Motter, and Rod Kempkes, has begun meeting and will be recommending to the Board that Cedars should begin pursuing **part-time contract ministry** as the preferred type of professional ministry to meet the needs of our community at this time. 




